


CHOLA'S GOT

It's been two years in Chola, and what an incredible journey it has been!



However, with proper warm-ups and conditioning, injuries can be minimized.






WHAT HAS BEEN YOUR BIGGEST STAGE PERFORMANCE SO FAR?
