### How to stay protected?

- Do not click on links received via SMS messages claiming pending traffic challans
- Do not make payments under pressure or threat of legal action
- Verify challan details through official Government websites or applications
- Never share card details, OTPs, CVV, or personal information
- Ignore messages that contain shortened links or urgent payment deadlines
