After worker's death, cops book case against firm

POLICE on Sunday registered a case of negligence against Party.com, a firm which organises parties, after one worker died and another was injured, when a helium cylinder exploded in an apartment premises in Ashok Nagar on Saturday evening.

The company did not provide any safety gear to the workers, it is alleged.

The deceased was identified as Dinesh M, a resident of Parappana Agrahara, who had come to decorate the apartment with balloons, for a birthday celebration. One of the residents had organised a surprise birthday bash.

"A senior police officer said the incident occurred around 7.45pm in an apartment on Langford Road, and one of the residents had "a plan to celebrate her male friend's birthday. She had ordered balloons on Party.com, and Dinesh and his assistant Mahadev came to decorate 200 balloons. The birthday boy, who was in a hotel, did not turn up due to the mishap."

He had kept the cylinder on his scooter Dinesh was filling the balloons near the entrance and while filling them with helium. When it exploded, Dinesh sustained severe injuries and died on the spot, while Mahadev suffered minor injuries and was rushed to a nearby hospital for first aid. The duo was not following scientific methods to fill the balloons, police said.

Investigations are on and action will be initiated soon. The body was handed over to the family on Sunday after the postmortem, and a notice will be issued to the company on Monday, the police officer added.

STALIN TO BSY: SCRAP MEKEDATU PROJECT

Rejects K'taka stand that it won't affect TN farmers

TAMIL Nadu Chief Minister MK Stalin on Sunday wrote to his Karnataka counterpart BS Yediyurappa, urging him not to pursue the Mekedatu dam project. A day earlier, Yediyurappa had written to Stalin, seeking a bilateral meeting between the States to address apprehensions over the reservoircum-drinking water project.

In his letter, Stalin recalled the Cauvery tribunal's verdict that the three components of the annual quantum of water to be delivered by Karnataka at the inter-State contact point have been clearly identified. The proposed Mekedatu project would impound and divert the first



component of uncontrolled flow due to Tamil Nadu, i.e. the flow of the river Cauvery from the uncontrolled catchment of Kabini sub-basin downstream of Kabini reservoir, the catchment of the main stream of the Cauvery below Krishnarajasahara, uncontrolled flow from Simsha, Arkavathy and Suvernavathy sub-basins, and various other small streams.

Uncontrolled water flow is

one of the three components contributing to the annual quantum of water to be delivered by Karnataka to Tamil Nadu, and this has been identified in the Cauvery tribunal order as modified by the Supreme Court, he added.

Stalin also rejected Karnataka's stand that the Mekedatu dam project would not affect the interests of farmers in Tamil Nadu.

On Yediyurappa referring to two hydropower projects in Tamil Nadu, Stalin said they cannot be compared to the Mekedatu project, which is intended to store 67.16 TMC of water. The two hydropower projects don't consume water, as the available water is recirculated to meet the peak power demand, he said.

"NavIC enhances the accuracy and availability of signals in the hilly terrain as well as urban canyon. The NavIC-enabled handheld devices can harness this benefit," ISRO said. ISRO has urged Garmin to make NavIC an integral part of all their upcoming satellite navigation-based devices in India.
